"No matter where you are, maintain a sense of optimism enough so that you can stay on the path. Try to nurture that within yourself and react to that in a positive way rather than letting it halt you in your tracks. Convince yourself that it's worthwhile and the journey is long. Do whatever you have to do to keep going and be motivated."
